A Project

Do some research to find a chemical reaction that is important for some reason. It should be a natural or industrial application (make sure it's appropriate for class). Once you've chosen a reaction, make sure to get it approved before you continue. Prepare a small poster (on 8.5" x 14" paper) about the reaction you chose which includes all the information outlined below. Be prepared for your poster to be displayed in class.

Your poster must include:

1. The name of the reaction.
2. A balanced chemical equation.
3. The reaction type.
4. Where the reaction occurs.
5. A brief history of the reaction.
6. Any other significance of reaction.
7. A diagram or picture to support your text.

Check the rubric to see how your poster will be evaluated.
